Lead Rider briefing procedure. (Please follow the order listed to ensure the most important information is covered first)

1. Buddy up pairs of riders, explain they must look for each other at every stop, including when regrouping.
2. Nominate Tail-End Charlie & Report Writer, record mobile numbers of both TEC & RW on this form.
3. Describe Corner Marking as detailed "When I (the lead rider), come to a change of direction in the route, I will indicate to the rider immediately behind to stop and mark the corner. That rider MUST stop and indicate what direction the following riders should take and to STAY at the corner until Tail End Charlie arrives. EVERYONE UNDERSTAND?"
4. LEAD RIDER TO THEN CLEARLY IDENTIFY TAIL END CHARLIE TO THE GROUP
5. Explain Road conditions, etc, Km's to be covered, Major Stops, petrol and toilet stops.
6. If you have a smart phone, take a photo of the form so LR & Ride Reporter have the information.
7. Once completed hand this form to the TEC or back up driver before commencement of ride.
8. SMS or email the report writers details to the club captain at the end of the ride.

Ride Report procedure

Thank you for agreeing / offering to write the ride report for this ride / event. Please follow this format: -

- Write your report as a word document.
- Include a list of the participants (names, bike make and model, year of bike)
- Please refrain from embarrassing other members in your report, unless it's a humorous comment that you know won't offend.
- Email your report and send to the **Vice President** as an attachment at vpres@cmccv.org.au.
- Please ensure any photo's that accompany your report are in "JPEG" format.
- Please keep the report to between 300 - 500 words to allow easy insertion into Sprocket.
- Deadline for Sprocket articles is the third Wednesday of each month.
